Brigadier General (ITA Army) Roberto VERGORI



Brigadier General Roberto Vergori was born in LECCE, on 28th September 1971.

He attended the 172nd Course at the Military Academy of MODENA from 1990 to 1992. Upon graduation, he moved on to the Application School in TORINO, where he remained until 1995.

Promoted to Lieutenant in 1994, he was assigned to the 183rd "Nembo" parachute regiment in PISTOIA, where he served in numerous command and staff positions, to include Rifle Platoon Commander, Commander of heavy mortars company, Commander of the command and logistic support company, Officer in charge of Operations and Training and, lastly, Head of Operations, Training and Information.

After attending, from 2003 to 2004, the 130th Army Staff Course (1st session) and the 7th Plurithematic Course, he was assigned to the Personnel Department of the Army Staff, where he served until 2008.

In 2007 he was promoted to Major and from 2008 to 2009 he attended the "Advanced Command and Staff Course 12" in the UK, where he subsequently served as the Italian Army Military Representative to the British Army Staff until September 2011.

Afterwards, he was appointed as Head of Section of the General Office of the Deputy Chief of the Staff of the Italian Army.

In November 2012, in LIVORNO, he assumed command of the 2nd "Tarquinia" battalion of the 187th "Folgore" parachute regiment, responsible for its preparation for the Joint Rapid Reaction Force (JRRF).

From December 2013 to August 2016 he was assigned to the Joint Operations Command, in ROMA, as Section Head of the Office of Commander, where subsequently he held the position of Head of the Office.

From March to July 2016, he was Military Assistant to the Force Commander / Head of Mission of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL).

In July 2016 he was promoted to Colonel. In September 2016 he assumed command of the 5th "Aosta" rifle regiment in MESSINA, of which he was the 123rd Commander until February 2018. Under his leadership, the regiment carried out the preparation for the Joint Rapid Reaction Force (JRRF) and, in June 2017, framed the "Taormina 1" Joint Task Force deployed to secure the "G7", held in TAORMINA.

As of February 2018, he was assigned to the Joint Operations Command as J3 Division Chief, in ROMA. From August 2020 to October 2021, he commanded the Bilateral Assistance and Support Mission in LIBYA. He was promoted to Brigadier General in January 2021.

In October 2021, he took over command of the "Folgore" Airborne Brigade. From February 2023 to August 2023 he commanded the Joint Task Force Lebanon Sector West under UN mandate (UNIFIL).

In October 2023, he has been appointed as Commander of the Army NCO Academy in VITERBO.

Brigadier General Vergori has completed multiple deployments during his career, to include KOSOVO, FYROM, AFGHANISTAN, LEBANON and LIBYA.

He has achieved numerous airborne qualifications, including the free fall technique. He also attended the 2nd Special Forces International Course in VENEZUELA and other specialization courses abroad.
